Willow Creek- Fantastic fishing below Harrison Reservoir located on a private ranch near Three Forks, Montana. The creek has a good population of rainbows and brown trout, and provides excellent dry fly fishing. Only a hand full of anglers are allowed on this ranch each day.

Willow Creek Café & Saloon-This place is a find, if you can find it... It began as the Babcock Saloon around 1916, and continues as a remarkable reflection of what's best in Montana: hearty meals and friendly people. The ever-popular baby back pork ribs draw repeat customers from around the country, but the local cowboys know that the beef is tops here, so the hand-pounded chicken-fried sirloin steak is their recommendation.
